- 4,273 individuals received healthy, nutritious meals

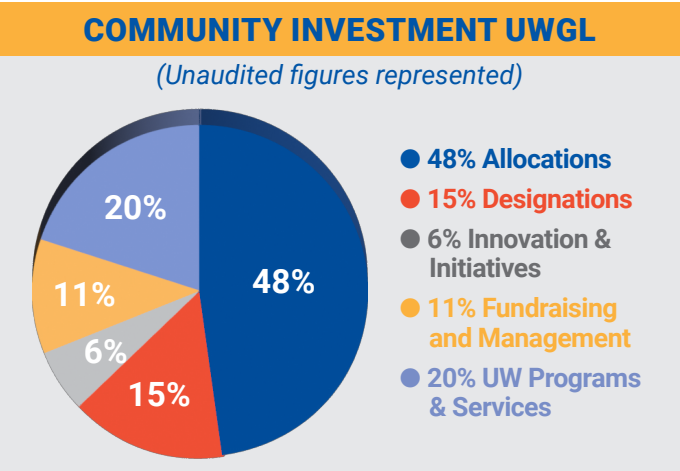
INNOVATION GRANTS

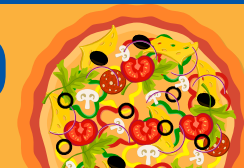
